### Treasurers Report

I am pleased to report that the financial status of the society continues in good health. We keep 75% of our cash assets in an interest bearing account with the Charity Bank.

Membership remains around 230 household memberships.

In looking at the year on year comparison I would draw your attention to the fact that the previous financial year was 14 months as we moved to a calendar year end as opposed to October.

This will only affect the income as the expenses are pretty much fixed over the year.

In fact pro rata the income is slightly more in the 2025 financial year.

On the expense side the society made a contribution to the St Nicholas Asbestos removal fund of £750. This was a one off non re-occurring expense.

Looking to the year ahead Taplow is threatened with ever expanding threats to green belt status. The Parish Council are working towards a neighbourhood plan and the society will be providing support wherever possible to this activity.

Many thanks to Perry Ashwood who cast a professional eye over the accounts and verified everything was shipshape.
